- Rehearsals (6pm-9:30pm) Monday-Friday
- Tech Sunday, September 20th from 12pm-10pm
- Performances October 3rd-20th (Thursdays and Fridays at 7:00pm & Saturdays and Sundays at 2:00pm).
 - This includes—recurring conflicts such as classes and lessons, other rehearsals, extracurricular activities, and appointments
 - Please also list all single conflict dates such as, special events, school concerts, weddings, appointments, and celebrations.

Please note all special skills and the roles you are interested in auditioning for, including ensemble.

Unable to Attend in Person?

If you are unable to attend auditions in person, please select the **5:00pm Friday, July 26th audition slot**, <u>https://koalendar.com/e/oliver-auditions</u>, and fill out an audition form.

You will need to film yourself singing or have someone record you while you sing along to the accompaniment track.

You do not need to be memorized and are encouraged to use the sheet music if needed.

Please state your name before you sing.

After filming your audition, email us your video or a link to your video to auditions@lacrossetheatre.org by **5:00pm Friday, July 26th**. Late submissions will not be considered.

If you are unable to attend callbacks, please state that as a conflict on your audition form.

If we need to see you for a callback and you are unable to attend, we will send you the callback material on Monday, July 29th, which may consist of a song and/or a scene.

If it is a song, we will provide accompaniment and a melody track. Please play the accompaniment track and sing to it. You do not need to be memorized.

If it is a scene, please read the scene on camera and have another person read the scene on or off camera with you. You do not be memorized.

Callback videos will be due by 5:00pm Wednesday, July 31st.
